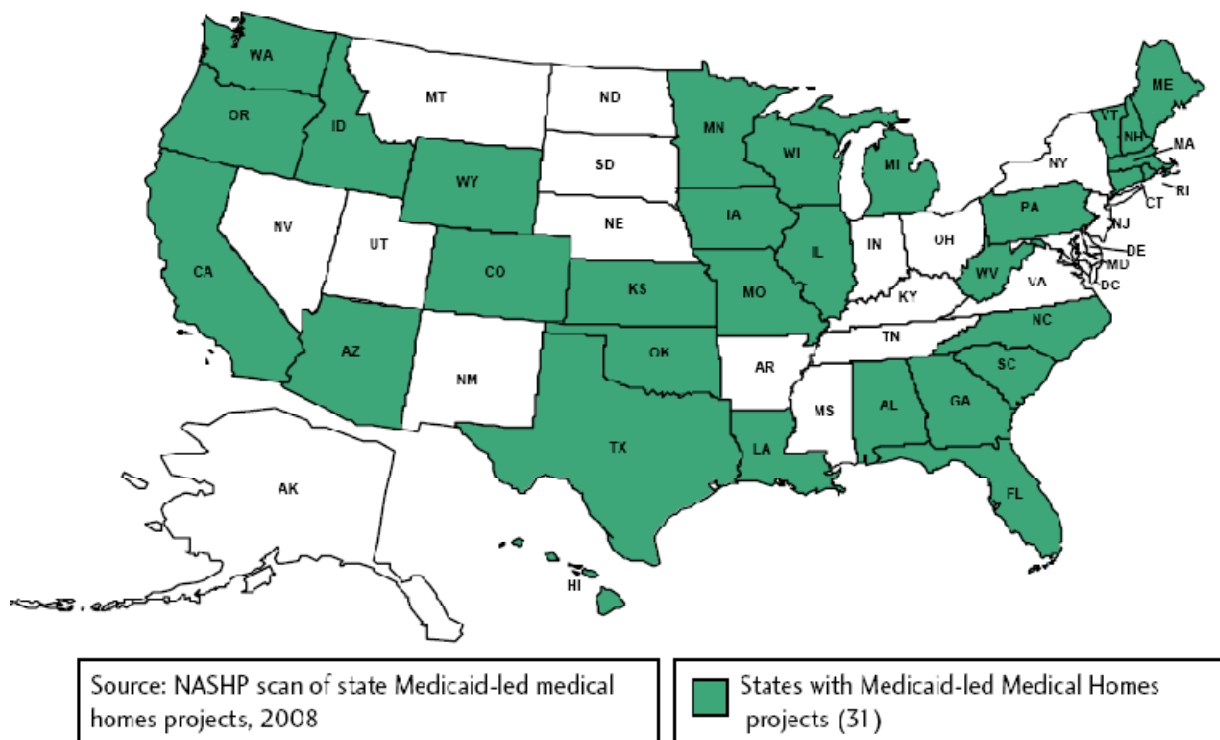


States with Medical Home Projects and Community Utilities

Many states across the country have been implementing medical homes in their communities. Utilizing a strategy like community utilities can bring the patient-centered medical home (PCMH) approach to small, primary care practices that otherwise would not be able to afford a group of care coordinators, health information technology, or other components of the PCMH. More than 80% of US primary care practices have just one of two physicians on the staff, and 40% of the total physician capacity involves these very small practices (Zoler, 2009). Therefore, it is critical for many medical home initiatives to utilize shared community resources.

The following is not a comprehensive list of states that have community utilities as part of their medical home effort. It became clear while researching this topic that practically all states with a medical home initiative recognize the importance of sharing or linking community resources in order to best meet the requirements of a medical home to some degree. States call these utilities different names (Community Care Teams, Care Coordinators, Community Utilities, etc), focus on specific populations, and share or collaborate to various degrees. Nevertheless, this component of medical home is used throughout the US.
